2024 JAM Call for Papers Terms/Conditions

Want to improve the likelihood that your paper gets accepted?

1. Complete your submission by the deadline (Friday, October 27, 2023). The submittal must be complete with speaker information, presentation title, and abstract. Identify all presenters at the time of submission.
 2. Please ensure, to the greatest extent possible, that all presenters will be available for both days of technical presentations at the conference (Monday, March 25, 2024, and Tuesday, March 26, 2024).
 3. Think of a creative, eye-catching presentation title that is clear and concise.
 4. Carefully write your abstract or a narrative description of your presentation.
 - Abstracts should be no longer than 2,500 characters.

- When preparing your abstract, focus on clearly articulating the following:
 - o Purpose of your presentation
 - o Benefit and relevance to the water/wastewater industry
 - o Provide enough details to show 50-minutes of content
 - o Alternatives evaluated and project status
 - o Key findings and conclusions
 - o Unique aspects of your project
 - Omit any graphics or attachments – please submit text only. If a list is included, please provide a numbered list instead of a bulleted list.
